Dear Parents and Campers,

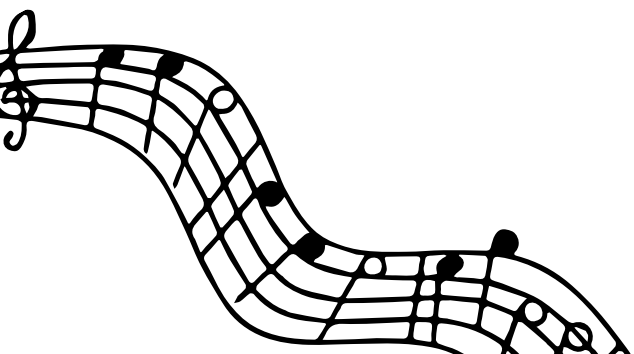
